### 3M™ Engineer Grade Reflective Sheeting

**Type:** enclosed lens reflective sheeting.

**Best for:** This material is typically used for signs in areas with low volume, lower speed traffic and little competing surrounding light.

**Reflectivity:** exceeds specification ASTM D 4956-04 Type I.



### 3M™ High Intensity Reflective Sheeting

**Type:** encapsulated lens reflective sheeting.

**Best for:** all traffic situations. High Intensity is highly reflective at wide angles to approaching traffic and continues to be a proven performer.

**Reflectivity:** exceeds specification ASTM D 4956-04, Type III.

**Type:** unique prismatic construction sheeting. Backed by 3M™ reliability.

**Best for:** all traffic situations. High Intensity Prismatic is highly reflective at wide angles to approaching traffic.
